\*\*This CIP project is for required plan check and related staff time. The Public Works Department has entered into an agreement with ACE for cost reimbursement.

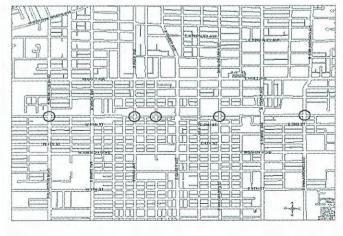
