Demolition of In-Ground Swimming Pools & Spas

- 1. Obtain a Demolition permit from the Building and Safety Department.

 NOTE: You will need a site/plot plan showing pool/spa dimensions and setbacks from property lines and other structures on the property.
- 2. Break out and remove a 3ft square section of the bottom at each end of the pool.
- 3. Remove the coping and the bond beam around the perimeter of the pool to 12" below grade.
- 4. Remove and cap all electrical, gas and water line to main service.
- 5. Call for an inspection of the work performed to this point. **DO NOT BACK- FILL** with any materials until the Building Inspector has authorized you to proceed.
- 6. Re-establish proper drainage: (2% from building or 1% to an approved disposal area)
- 7. A soil compaction report, certifying a compaction of 90/95% will be required at the time of final inspection **ONLY** if future building or structure is to be built directly above the abandoned swimming pool location.
- 8. **NOTE:** Back fill material shall consist of clean soil or gravel.
