NEIGHBORHOOD SERVICES

POMONA HOUSING AUTHORITY WILL BE ACCEPTING ONLINE APPLICATIONS TO PLACE ON PROGRAM WAITING LIST

The Pomona Housing Authority will be accepting online applications for the Housing Choice Voucher (HCV, also known as “Section 8”) program in early May 2021.

Exact dates and times will be posted on the City’s website, shared through social media and with our community partners in the coming weeks.

The HCV program provides rental assistance to low-income households, which helps them afford safe, quality housing. The PHA will be accepting pre-applications online and the application portal will be available 24 hours a day during the waiting list open period. Paper applications and fax requests **WILL NOT** be available or accepted.

The waiting list will only be open for those who qualify for the following preferences:

Homeless – To qualify for the Homeless preference, an applicant family/individual must be Homeless with ties to Pomona. Only applicants that verifiably lack housing and are identified by City of Pomona staff or partners (i.e. Pomona Police Department, Pomona Fire Department, Code Enforcement personnel, Homeless Services/Outreach Team and/or recognized Homeless Service Organization) as being homeless in Pomona, will be considered qualified.

Mainstream – To qualify for the Mainstream Preference, a household member must satisfy all three eligibility criteria: (1) must be between 18 and 61 years old, (2) must be disabled, (3) must be homeless in Pomona (see definition above) and working with a recognized Homeless Service Organization in Pomona.

Resident – To qualify for the Resident Preference, an applicant family/individual must live or work or have been hired to work 30 hours or more per week or enrolled in an accredited educational program designed to prepare the individual for the job market, or are attending school full-time in Pomona.

Please note that priority is given within the preference to veterans and/or active duty service people and their spouse or widow/er. It is very important that ALL applicants read the preference criteria carefully and make sure to check each box for any eligible preferences. Applicants that do not meet at least one of the qualifying priorities will not be considered for placement on the waiting list.

The PHA will use a lottery system to select applicants to be placed onto the waiting list. This means that applicants have an equal chance of placement and order on the waiting list if they apply on any date and any time during which the waiting list is open. As vouchers become available, pre-applications will be pulled from the waiting list in the order in which they were placed by the lottery.

SNAP A SPRING SELFIE PHOTO EXPERIENCE

Due to COVID-19 and in lieu of the City's annual Easter Egg Hunts, the City's Community Services Division will be offering a **Snap A Spring Selfie** photo experience on Saturday, April 3rd at Washington Park (865 E Grand Ave, Pomona) from 10:00a.m. - 1:00p.m. This activity will allow community members the opportunity to take selfies in front of six Spring themed photo back drops. Children age eleven and under will receive a goodie bag of plastic eggs with candy inside (while supplies last). This experience will require the community to wear face coverings at all times, even while taking photos, and will require the community to maintain a social distance from others outside of their household.

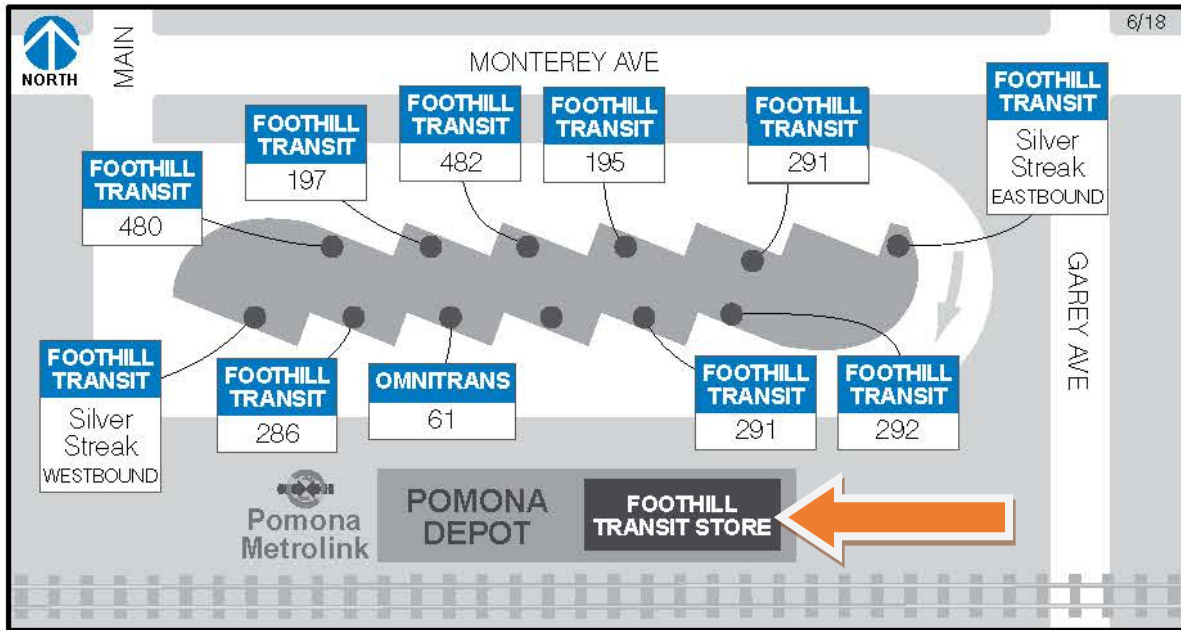

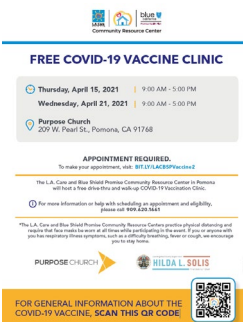

APPLY NOW – CA RENT RELIEF PROGRAM NOW OPEN!

As of March 15, 2021, both renters and landlords can check for eligibility and apply for CA COVID-19 Rent Relief. STATE EVICTION MORATORIUM & ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS

On Friday, January 29th, new State legislation extending an eviction moratorium through June 30, 2021 was signed! Read more on the [Governor's website](#) and at the [Housing is Key](#).

This new Program will allocate the \$2.6 billion in federal rental funds for California and aid income-qualified tenants most at-risk with unpaid back rent. Assistance will also be extended to property owners who agree to waive 20 percent of unpaid rent. By agreeing to this waiver, property owners will become eligible for 80 percent in rent reimbursements for amounts owed between April 1, 2020 and March 31, 2021.

EMERGENCY BROADBAND BENEFIT PROGRAM

The [FCC's Emergency Broadband Benefit](#) will provide a discount of up to \$50 per month towards broadband service for eligible households and up to \$75 per month for households on Tribal lands. Eligible households can also receive a one-time discount of up to \$100 to purchase a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet from participating providers if they contribute \$10 to \$50 toward the purchase price. The Emergency Broadband Benefit is limited to one monthly service discount and one device discount per household.

APPLY APRIL 2021 – FEDERAL COVID-19 FUNERAL REIMBURSEMENTS

Starting next month, FEMA will begin accepting applications for financial assistance for COVID-19-related funeral expenses incurred after January 20, 2020. Of note, there is no requirement for the deceased person to have been a U.S. citizen, non-citizen national, or qualified alien. Please visit the [FEMA website](#) for eligibility and the checklist for documents –such as official death certificate, receipts, etc.–you may start gathering now. If you are eligible for funeral assistance you will receive a check by mail, or funds by direct deposit, depending on which option you choose when you apply for assistance.

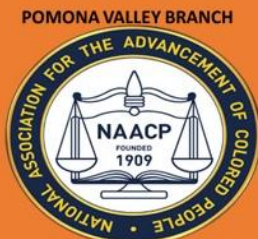

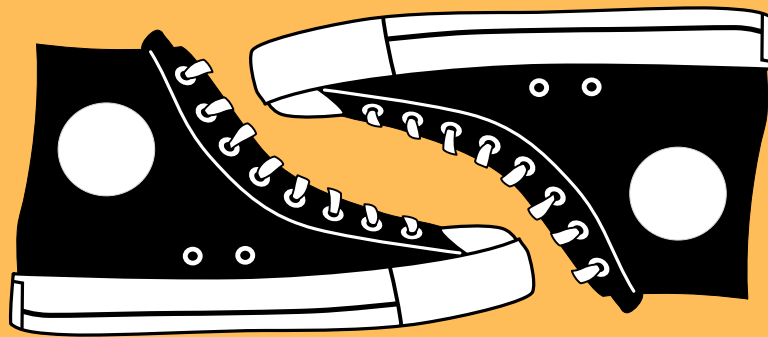

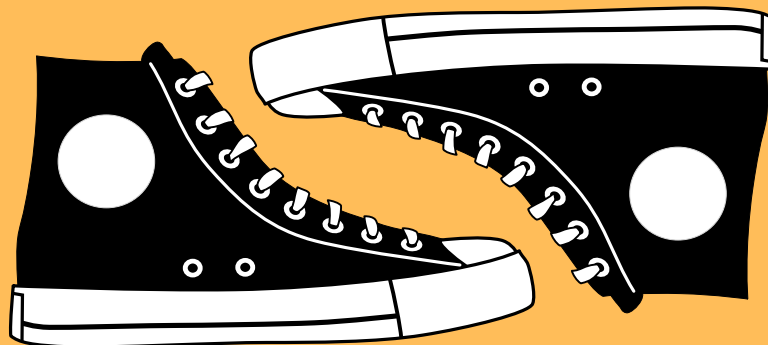
