MET Trainers and MILO

• The LASD Mental Evaluation Team is offering de-escalation training for sworn peace officers. MET Deputies conducting training are Certified Academy Instructors, Certified Force Options Simulator Instructors and Advanced Crisis Negotiators.

• The MILO simulator is a portable, immersive, interactive video training put on by the LASD MET. The simulator will be set up at San Gabriel PD for the listed dates only. Scenarios involving individuals with mental health issues, developmental disabilities or intellectual disabilities are used to challenge participants to use all their available resources and skills.



Training Day Breakdown

• Instructors discuss force related topics including de-escalation, force related case law, and applicable MMP sections. A period of instruction is conducted regarding the Project Lifesaver Program.

• This training covers some of the mandates required under AB 392 and SB 230, as well as PC sections, 192 and 835a regarding justifiable homicide by a peace officer and using force while affecting arrest.

• Participants will go through a MILO simulator phase and debriefing. The approximate duration of the training will depend on the participants' performance.
