Neighborhood Housing Legal Services of L.A. County (NLSLA) is now on-site at Pomona City Hall to provide Legal Services Clinics twice a week (bi-weekly) to Pomona residents in need of legal assistance. Clinics will be held on Mondays and Wednesdays for four (4) hours per clinic.

2. One-on-one advocacy to Pomona residents that include development of a legal plan designed to address their legal impediments.

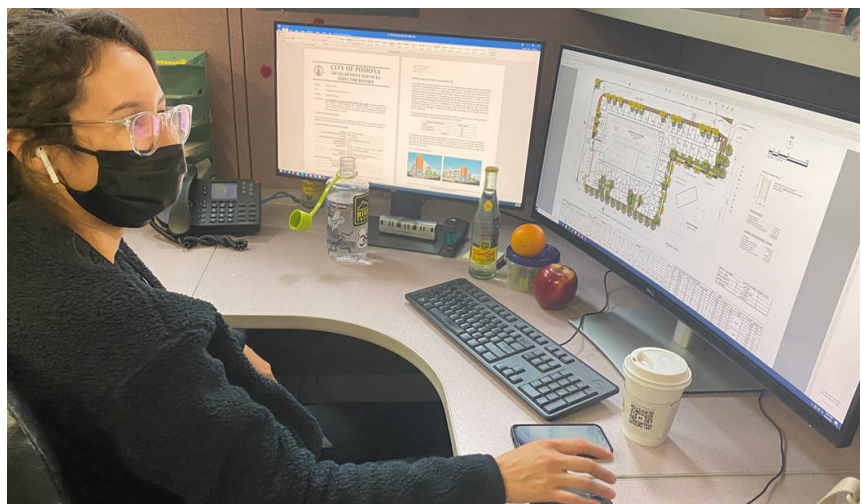

PLANNING DIVISION BEGINS TECH UPGRADE

The Planning Division has implemented Phase 1 of a \$150,000 Technology Upgrade, which includes new large-format monitors for digital plan check and entitlement review, and software upgrades to Adobe Acrobat. Phase 2, also currently underway, includes a Citywide upgrade to EnerGov to include “e-review” to enable 100% electronic payment and submittal, GIS 3-D modeling



for potential projects, and other software enhancements. The effort is being funded through grant dollars from the State Housing and Community Development Department, which were awarded to the City of Pomona to streamline the review of housing projects to facilitate faster housing production.

PUBLIC WORKS

SR 71-EXPRESSWAY-TO-FREEWAY CONVERSION PROJECT - VIRTUAL MEETING

You're invited! Caltrans will host a virtual community meeting on Wednesday, April 28, 2021, from 6:00-8:00 p.m. to discuss the State Route 71 expressway-to-freeway conversion project. The SR-71 expressway serves heavy commuter traffic originating in the communities of Chino, Ontario, and Pomona that are destined for employment centers in Orange and Los Angeles Counties. The purpose of this project is to alleviate traffic congestion by increasing the capacity on State Route 71 from Interstate 10 to State Route 60. The project will include converting the four-lane Expressway to an eight-lane freeway.

APPLY NOW – CA RENT RELIEF PROGRAM NOW OPEN!

As of March 15, 2021, both renters and landlords can check for eligibility and apply for CA COVID-19 Rent Relief. STATE EVICTION MORATORIUM & ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS

On Friday, January 29th, new State legislation extending an eviction moratorium through June 30, 2021 was signed! Read more on the [Governor's website](#) and at the [Housing is Key](#).

This new Program will allocate the \$2.6 billion in federal rental funds for California and aid income-qualified tenants most at-risk with unpaid back rent. Assistance will also be extended to property owners who agree to waive 20 percent of unpaid rent. By agreeing to this waiver, property owners will become eligible for 80 percent in rent reimbursements for amounts owed between April 1, 2020 and March 31, 2021.

EMERGENCY BROADBAND BENEFIT PROGRAM

The [FCC's Emergency Broadband Benefit](#) will provide a discount of up to \$50 per month towards broadband service for eligible households and up to \$75 per month for households on Tribal lands. Eligible households can also receive a one-time discount of up to \$100 to purchase a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet from participating providers if they contribute \$10 to \$50 toward the purchase price. The Emergency Broadband Benefit is limited to one monthly service discount and one device discount per household.

APPLY NOW – FEDERAL COVID-19 FUNERAL REIMBURSEMENTS


FEMA is accepting applications for financial assistance for COVID-19-related funeral expenses incurred after January 20, 2020. Of note, there is no requirement for the deceased person to have been a U.S. citizen, non-citizen national, or qualified alien. Please visit the [FEMA website](#) for eligibility and the checklist for documents –such as official death certificate, receipts, etc. If you are eligible for funeral assistance you will receive a check by mail, or funds by direct deposit, depending on which option you choose when you apply for assistance.

COVID-19 FUNERAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM
Financial help available for funeral expenses

To be eligible, LA County residents must meet three important conditions established by FEMA:

- The death must have occurred in the United States, including the U.S. territories, and the District of Columbia.
- The death certificate must indicate the death was attributed to COVID-19.
- The applicant must be a U.S. citizen, non-citizen national, or a qualified non-citizen who incurred funeral expenses after January 20, 2020.
