## ***PUBLIC WORKS***

### **VALLEY BOULEVARD MAJOR STREETS CONSTRUCTION – REMINDER**

The Department of Public Works would like to remind the public that construction on Valley Boulevard is well underway, with major work beginning. This work will require a “traffic switch” on May 21 - 22, 2021. The “traffic switch” means that vehicles traveling in both directions will be directed to travel on the northside of Valley Boulevard only. This will provide the Contractor with safe and ample access to the southside of Valley Boulevard to begin the demolition and removal of the old road pavement and concrete sub-base.

Since the beginning of March 8th and through summer 2021, Valley Boulevard (from Temple Avenue to Humane Way) is undergoing major reconstruction. Drivers will continue to see traffic control measures allowing for two-way, single-lane traffic movement on the south side of Valley Boulevard, while construction work continues on the north side of the street. This temporary traffic pattern will end and “switch” on May 21 & 22, 2021, as construction work on the south side of the street will commence and the vehicular travel way will be “switched” onto the northside of Valley Boulevard. Announcements on social media will be made at that time.

As construction continues, motorists are urged to remember the speed limit in the work zone. Please allow extra time to get to your destination if travelling through this area. We appreciate your patience and cooperation during this time.

The reconstruction of Valley Boulevard will be particularly intensive due mainly to the removal of old concrete under the existing surface of old asphalt. **Please spread the word about this pending construction project and be prepared for significant delays during this major construction work on Valley Boulevard.**

The City of Pomona’s Contractor, All American Asphalt, will be constructing “Major Street Rehabilitation – 2015 Metro Call”, Project No. 428-67918, which includes Valley Boulevard and other streets as discussed further below. This \$10M project is made possible in part by a \$3M Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Metro) grant from which funding has been made available starting this fiscal year 2020-21.

The main grant funded work of this project will be to add Active Transportation in the form of bicycle facilities on all of the following streets:

- Valley Boulevard (Temple Avenue to Humane Way)
- Orange Grove Avenue (Fairplex Drive to Casa Vista Drive and Artesia Street to Arrow Highway)
- Park Avenue (Mission Boulevard to Olive Street)
- San Antonio Avenue (County Road to Franklin Avenue and Phillips Boulevard to Mission Boulevard)
- McKinley Avenue (Fairplex Drive to Towne Avenue)

These streets and potential additive alternate streets (Humane Way, additional portions of McKinley Avenue, etc.) are shown on the attached (“Metro Call”) Map, and the planned construction for these streets is to include pavement rehabilitation in addition to the bicycle facilities. The pavement rehabilitation will range from slurry seals to thin



and thick grind and overlays, as well as the Valley Boulevard reconstruction. Construction of the above streets is expected to be complete within 1 year (Valley Boulevard is intended to be completed mainly in the Spring & Summer of 2021). See attached map.

**SOLID WASTE TRUCK LOAD CATCHES FIRE NEAR 1<sup>ST</sup> ST. AND WHITE AVE.**

On Thursday, May 13, at approximately 11:30 am, a Solid Waste Driver noticed smoke coming out of the back of his truck. Acting immediately, the driver turned onto 1<sup>st</sup> St. from White Ave. to get away from heavier traffic, and called 911. Two County Fire engines responded. As trained, the driver dumped a portion of the load on to the street to minimize damage to the truck. The Fire Department completely extinguished the load with foam and water. The Solid Waste Manager and Supervisor were quickly on scene. Streets staff cleared the area of all debris including litter removal in the immediate surrounding area. The collected debris and the remaining load in the truck were taken to Pomona Valley Transfer station to be dumped.

At this time, the cause of the fire is undetermined.

## **EMERGENCY BROADBAND BENEFIT PROGRAM**

The [FCC's Emergency Broadband Benefit](#) will provide a discount of up to \$50 per month towards broadband service for eligible households and up to \$75 per month for households on Tribal lands. Eligible households can also receive a one-time discount of up to \$100 to purchase a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet from participating providers if they contribute \$10 to \$50 toward the purchase price. The Emergency Broadband Benefit is limited to one monthly service discount and one device discount per household.

**COVID-19 FUNERAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM**  
*Financial help available for funeral expenses*

To be eligible, LA County residents must meet three important conditions established by FEMA:

- The death must have occurred in the United States, including the U.S. territories, and the District of Columbia.
- The death certificate must indicate the death was attributed to COVID-19.
- The applicant must be a U.S. citizen, non-citizen national, or a qualified non-citizen who incurred funeral expenses after January 20, 2020.

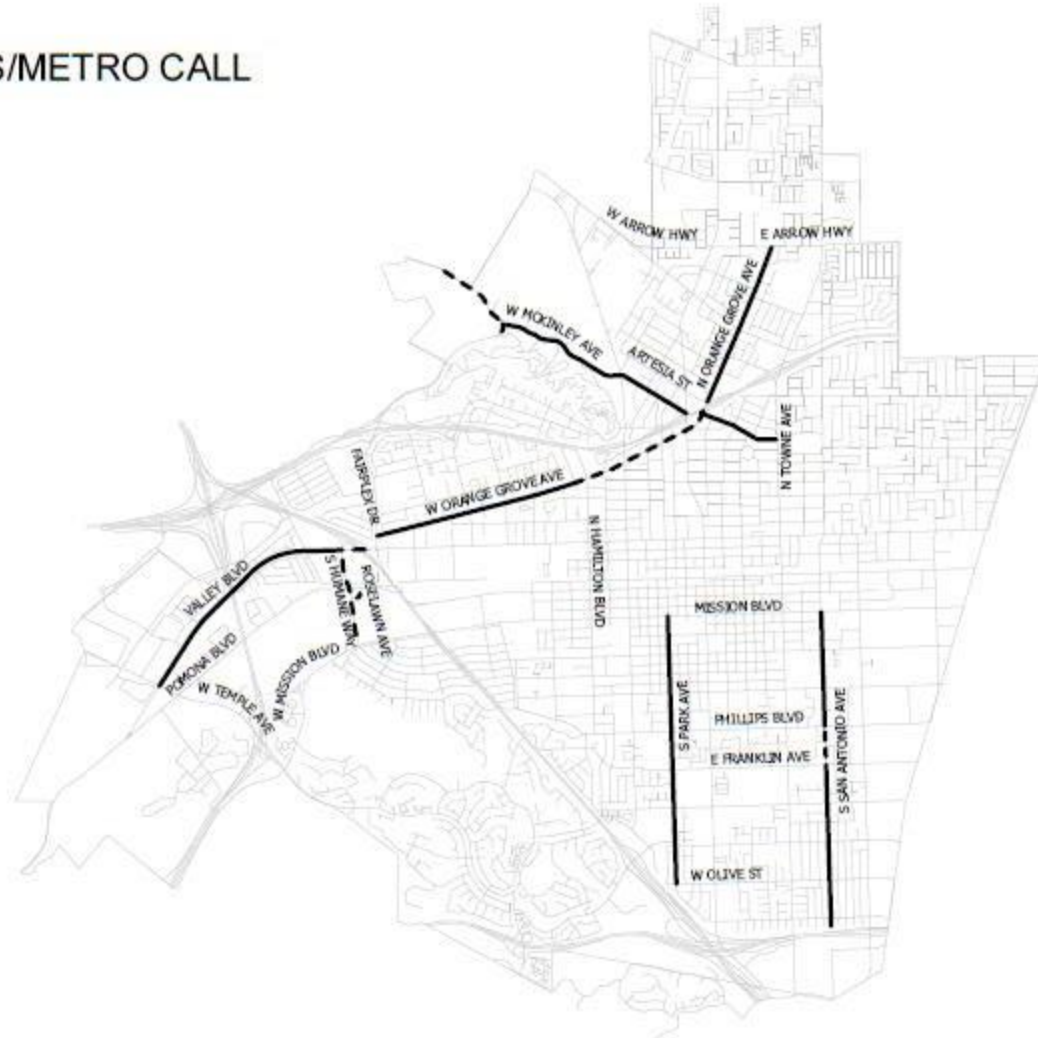
