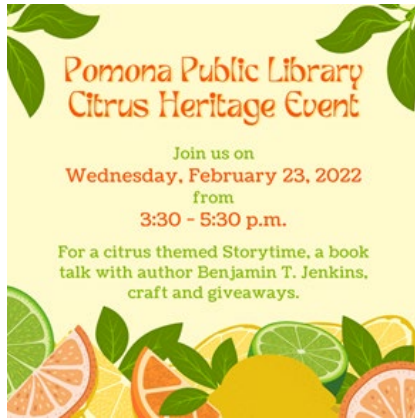

PUBLIC WORKS

TRAFFIC SIGNAL POLE REPAIR – TOWNE AVENUE AND BONITA AVE.

The traffic signal pole at the northeast corner of Towne Avenue and Bonita Avenue has been replaced as of February 2, 2022, and the signalized intersection has returned to normal operation. The traffic signal pole was knocked down as a result of a traffic accident.



HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE AND ELECTRONIC WASTE ROUNDUPS – FEBRUARY 5, 2022

The County of Los Angeles and the Sanitation Districts of Los Angeles County are hosting “Too Toxic to Trash” – a free event for Los Angeles County residents to dispose of unwanted household hazardous waste and electronic waste.

The event will be held on Saturday, February 5, 2022, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. at the Claremont Corporate Yard located at 1616 Monte Vista Avenue. NORTH METROLINK POMONA STATION – PARKING LOT DEMOLITION WORK

As part of the Foothill Gold Line light rail extension project, the contractor, KPJV, will begin demolition work within the North Metrolink Pomona Station beginning February 10, 2022. Temporary construction fencing will be installed on the entire northerly half of the parking lot so that KPJV can start with existing tree and fence removals. This demolition work is the first step towards the construction of the new Gold Line station platform. The temporary fencing is anticipated to remain in place until construction is complete.

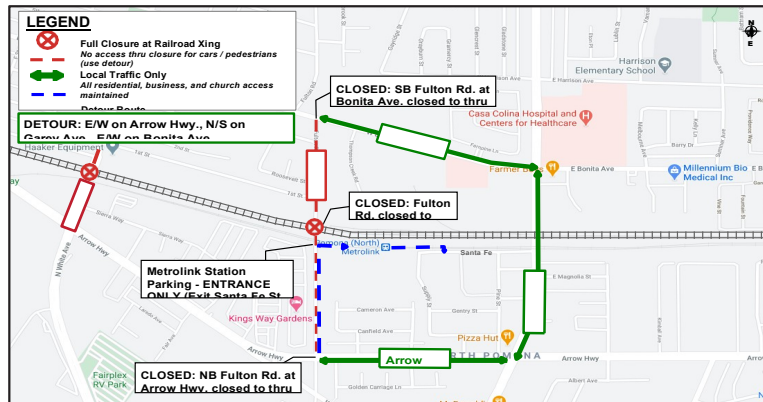
SCHEDULED FREEWAY CLOSURE – CALTRANS TO CONTINUE REPAIRING NORTHBOUND SR71 POTHOLES

As part of the ongoing efforts to keep the roads and highways operational during construction of the SR71 Widening Project, Caltrans will continue repairs to the existing potholes along the northbound lanes of the SR71, between Phillips Dr. and Mission Blvd. This operation will require the full overnight closure of the northbound SR71 on February 11, 2022, from Rio Rancho Rd. to Mission Blvd.

FULL STREET CLOSURE – FULTON RD. AT RAILROAD CROSSING

As part of the 9.1-mile Foothill Gold Line light rail project, starting Monday, February 7th and continuing through Friday, February 11th, 2022, Fulton Rd. will be fully closed to all traffic (vehicular and pedestrian) at the railroad crossing 24 hours a day. Arrow Hwy. (south of the crossing) and Bonita Ave. (north of the crossing) will remain open and accessible by way of detour routes (see map below). In addition, the Metrolink Station driveway on Fulton Rd. will be restricted to entrance only during the closure; vehicles will need to exit at Santa Fe St. to Garey Ave.

- Daily Work Hours: 6:00 AM - 11:00 PM. Overnight work and Sunday shifts may also be required.

EMERGENCY BROADBAND BENEFIT PROGRAM

The [FCC's Emergency Broadband Benefit](#) (The Affordable Connectivity Program replaced the Emergency Broadband Benefit on December 31, 2021) will provide a discount of up to \$30 per month towards broadband service for eligible households and up to \$75 per month for households on Tribal lands. Eligible households can also receive a one-time discount of up to \$100 to purchase a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet from participating providers if they contribute \$10 to \$50 toward the purchase price. The Emergency Broadband Benefit is limited to one monthly service discount and one device discount per household.

FEMA is accepting applications for financial assistance for COVID-19-related funeral expenses incurred after January 20, 2020.
