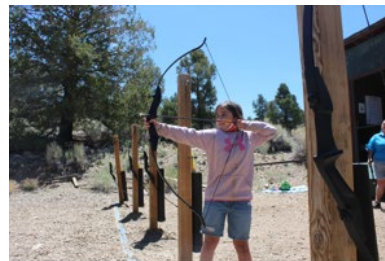

- May 13 – Washington Park


## **YOUTH DAY CAMP REGISTRATION FOR SUMMER 2022!**

## ***PUBLIC WORKS***

### **FREE COMPOST GIVEAWAY EVENT – May 14, 2022**

The Public Works Department is pleased to announce the second of four [free compost giveaway](#) events taking place on Saturday, May 14, 2022, from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. Compost creates healthier soil by adding organic matter and improving soil structure.

This self-serve event will take place at the City Yard located at 636 W. Monterey Ave. Residents will be limited to four 32-gallon containers of material. Residents are encouraged to bring durable containers, shovels, and gloves. The giveaway is on a first-come, first-serve basis.

The next two events will be held on May 21, 2022 and May 28, 2022 at the City Yard.

### **PARK PLAYGROUND RESURFACING**

The project to replace the existing playground rubberized surfacing has begun this week. The old rubberized playground surfacing at Memorial, Montvue, and Westmont Parks will be replaced with new, ADA-compliant rubberized surfacing, as funded by Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) monies. Please be advised that during construction, the playgrounds will be closed. The project is expected to be completed by June 30, 2022



### **REQUEST FOR PUBLIC INPUT – LOCAL ROADWAY SAFETY PLAN**

The City's Engineering Staff is working with a transportation consultant (KOA Corporation) to develop a Local Roadway Safety Plan (LRSP). A LRSP provides the framework for identifying, analyzing, and prioritizing roadway safety improvements on local roads. The LRSP development process and content are tailored to local issues and needs. The process results in a prioritized list of issues, risks, actions, and improvements that can be used to reduce fatalities and serious injuries on local roads (FHWA, n.d.). This Citywide plan will address data driven problems with recommended improvements that will potentially be programmed in future capital improvement projects. We are seeking your input to enhance roadway safety.
