POMONA TO RESUME REGULAR UTILITY SERVICE PAYMENT PRACTICES

Effective August 1, 2022, the City of Pomona will resume regular utility service payment and disconnection practices for delinquent customer accounts. Throughout the pandemic emergency, the City has made every effort to assist customers who have experienced difficulties paying their utility bill by:

- Suspended late payment penalties from March 2020 through June 2021.
- Suspended utility shutoffs for nonpayment from March 2020 through July 31, 2022.
- Utilized grant funds awarded by the State Water Resources Control Board to provide almost \$1,000,000 in credits to delinquent accounts.

The Payment/Shut-off timeline information is provided below:

- 1. The City provides customers with billing statements every 61 days.
- 2. Customers have 3 weeks or 21 days from the billing date to pay their water bill.
- 3. If payment is not received on the 21st day, the City will assess a 5% penalty on the total outstanding balance and the customer will be issued a past due notice on the 22nd day.

4. Delinquent bills must be paid by the 80th day after the billing date (postmarks are not acceptable) to avoid further penalties and service disconnection.

We understand the uncertainty and financial challenges that many households and commercial establishments are currently facing. Given these unique and unprecedented circumstances, we are offering impacted individuals and businesses the opportunity to request payment arrangements. PUBLIC WORKS

BRIDGE PROJECTS – CITYWIDE


The City of Pomona and the Los Angeles County Department of Public Works (LACoDPW) are working together (LACoDPW as the lead agency) to rehabilitate five bridges in the City (see map attached):

- 1st Street over Towne Avenue
- 9th Street over San Antonio Wash
- East End Avenue over San Antonio Wash
- Grand Avenue over San Antonio Wash
- Phillips Boulevard over San Antonio Wash

Peterson Chase, General Engineering Construction, Inc., is the Contractor for this work, which is part of a larger project for bridge preventative maintenance consisting of 26 bridges throughout Los Angeles County. The majority of the scope of work is concrete repair, pavement delineation removal/repair, and joint seal removal/replacement. Some locations will have AC (asphalt concrete) removal/replacement, along with placing bridge deck treatments.

The Contractor has operations being conducted during the day at various times with traffic control/lane closures. The work is anticipated to start on or around July 18, 2022, at the various locations with the unsound concrete work, pavement delineation, and bridge deck treatment(s). The work is anticipated to take four months to complete.

Each bridge only has a few shifts worth of work on it, so public inconvenience/impact is minimal. In addition, traffic control is a daily operation, so lane closures will be opened at the end of each shift.

FULL STREET CLOSURE - GAREY AVENUE

As part of the 9.1-mile Foothill Gold Line Project, Kiewit-Parsons, a joint venture (KPJV), crews will be working at the Garey Avenue railroad crossing to replace the existing Metrolink track. After the KPJV crew replaces the existing Metrolink track, they will work on repaving the work zone. This will result in a full closure of Garey Avenue at the railroad crossing beginning Friday, July 29 at 7:00 AM to Tuesday, August 2, 2022, at 7:00 AM. KPJV workers work around the clock, 24 hours a day, during this time.

Detour Routes (Green Arrows seen on the map below):


- Towne Avenue (Northbound and southbound) will be the main detour route.
- Arrow Highway (Eastbound and Westbound) will remain open to all traffic.
- Bonita Avenue (Eastbound and Westbound) will remain open.

Access to homes and businesses on Garey Avenue within the closure area north and south of the railroad crossing will be maintained at all times, as well as access to the Metrolink station from Fulton Road and Arrow Hwy/Pine Street (shown as blue spaced lines on the map below).

Residents and businesses located near the Garey Avenue rail crossing, between Arrow Hwy and Bonita Avenue, are advised to anticipate noise.

Later in the year, KPJV crews will close Garey Avenue again to complete the crossing reconstruction for the new light rail system. More information will be provided in the future.

FULTON ROAD FULL CLOSURE JULY 22- JULY 26, 2022

The Foothill Gold Line Construction Authority's Contractor (Kewit-Parsons, a joint venture) will conduct a full closure of Fulton Road from July 22 through July 26, 2022 for needed work at the rail crossing between Arrow Highway and Bonita Avenue. Work

associated with this closure will occur around the clock beginning at 7:00 A.M. Friday through 7:00 A.M. Monday.

The Metrolink Station parking lot will only be open and accessible via the Santa Fe Street driveway (Fulton Road driveway to the Metrolink parking lot will be closed). The detour for this closure will be on Garey Avenue via Bonita Avenue and Arrow Highway.


The schedule is weather permitting, and all dates and times are subject to change.

Detours will be posted. Motorists should expect delays and are strongly advised to avoid the area and use alternate routes.

SAN JOSE CREEK MULTI-USE BIKEWAY

The City of Pomona is excited to be awarding a contract to Alta Planning and Design Inc. for the design of "The San Jose Creek Multi-Use Bikeway" (SJC Bikeway). The project will create a pedestrian and cyclist-friendly path that will provide connectivity for students, residents, and visitors to local schools, parks, the Fairplex, and Cal Poly Pomona. The SJC Bikeway will include possible art amenities, mosaics, or murals along the path. In addition, SJC Bikeway will have some educational features that would potentially showcase the City's intention for sustainability. New pathway lighting, benches, and way-finding signage will be among the added features. The SJC Bikeway is 3.5 miles long and follows San Jose Creek from Temple Avenue to Murchison Avenue, alongside South Campus Drive. Alta Planning and Design will begin design in summer 2022. Opportunities for the public to provide feedback and input during the design phase will be provided during the design phase.

The bikeway will be classified as a Class 1 bike path. Class 1 bike paths are "facilities with exclusive right-of-way for bicyclists and pedestrians, away from the roadway". The Class 1 bike path will provide a much safer experience for both bicyclists and pedestrians.



WATER RESOURCES

POMONA CHOICE ENERGY HAS PARTNERED WITH OHMCONNECT

Pomona Choice Energy (PCE) and OhmConnect have partnered to bring residents a special offer. PCE customers can get paid to save electricity, and PCE residents and businesses can qualify to get \$10, plus a smart thermostat or two smart plugs for just \$0.99.

OhmConnect is a free service that rewards customers for saving energy. When signed up, the customer will receive alerts when energy is most expensive and gives off the most pollution. 
How Can OhmConnect pay you to reduce your energy consumption?
