

DUI/CDL CHECKPOINT


On Friday night, December 16th, the Police Department will conduct a two-direction checkpoint on a major thoroughfare in Pomona. This checkpoint is OTS grant funded and will start at 9:00 p.m.

SANTA COP TOY DISTRIBUTION

On Saturday, December 17th, from 9:00am-2:00pm, Pomona PD will be hosting its annual "Santa Cop" event at City Hall. The Santa Cop event is one where gifts are provided to children aged from infant to 15 years old whom come from families in need. Pomona PD staff recognizes this is often a tough time of year for those experiencing financial difficulties, thus the Santa Cop program was born. Those in need are identified through referrals from teachers, police staff, and community members. The gifts are all acquired through a series of fundraisers and donations, to include the Pancake Breakfast and Stuff-a-Cruiser events. Last year, PPD was able to provide gifts to over 100 families, which encompassed over 325 children. In addition to providing gifts for the children, there are also activities at City Hall that day. New registrations for this event is currently full and there is an established waiting list.

CHANGES ON HOW WE RESPOND TO CALLS FOR SERVICE

On November 21st, 2022 the Police Department presented several changes to the City Council on how we would respond to lower-priority calls for service from the community. Those changes were implemented on December 1st, 2022, and we have seen a significant positive impact on our overall response times. The changes include directing residents to our online reporting option for certain property crimes and non-injury traffic collisions. Police management will continue to monitor the impact of these changes and make any adjustments deemed appropriate to balance response times with our goal of excellent customer service.
