PUBLIC WORKS

SANDBAG DISTRIBUTION

The Public Works Department routinely provides sandbags to residents during major rain events. Residents can pick up sandbags during regular business hours at the Monterey Yard located at 636 West Monterey. Each resident is allowed a 20-sandbag maximum per residence. Streets Division personnel are available to assist Monday through Thursday; actual hours of distribution vary according to anticipated and actual rain accumulations. Please follow the City's social media platforms for current sandbag distribution times and updates for future rain events. Senior citizens or disabled residents can make special arrangements by contacting the Streets Division in advance at (909) 620-3665.

"AT THE CURB" CHRISTMAS TREE RECYCLING PROGRAM

The City will continue collecting discarded Christmas trees at the curb through January 20, 2023. Trees collected at curbside are taken to centralized locations for chipping and grinding. This service helps reduce and/or eliminate the possibility of discarded trees in the streets, alleys and sidewalks.

METROLINK RAILROAD MAINTENANCE

To keep train service safe and reliable, Metrolink will be performing railroad maintenance along the San Bernardino Line, between the cities of La Verne and Pomona. Crews will perform surfacing, regulating, and stabilizing track work. This activity corrects the alignment of the rails resulting in the safer operation of trains.

This week-night work will take place between 10:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. beginning Thursday, Jan. 12 through Thursday, Jan. 19.

Metrolink anticipates the following impacts:

- Noise from equipment, backup alarms and heavy machinery
- Noise, vibrations and dust from construction machinery and activities
- Lights from light towers and/or on-track equipment
