## ***INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY***

### **PDIT APP UPGRADES**

PDIT recently upgraded four applications and two servers to introduce new features and to strengthen our overall cybersecurity posture. The specialized software upgrades benefitted the Internal Affairs, Jailer, and Training teams.

### **GETTING RUGGED WITH IT**

PDIT deployed three pilot rugged tablets to the Traffic Division so that the full suite of PD applications can be accessed from the field, another five are expected to be deployed in the upcoming weeks. Rugged tablets are specialized mobile devices that are designed to operate under harsh conditions and withstand drops and vibrations, extreme temperatures, and wet and dusty environments.

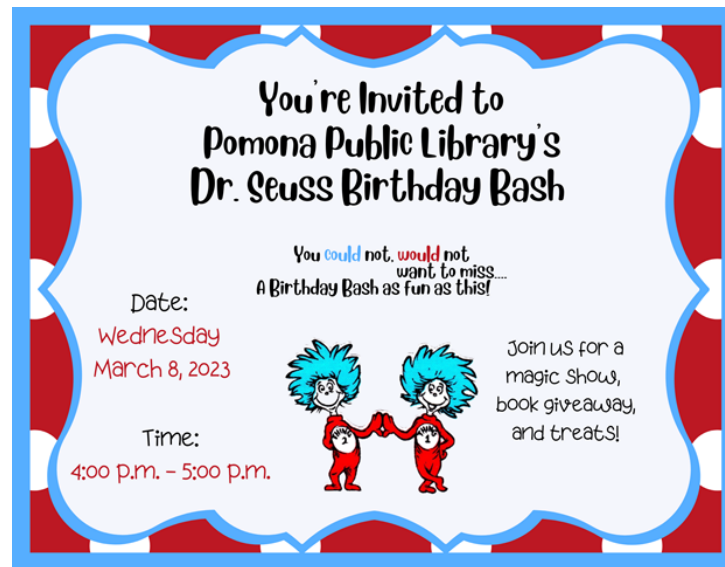
### **DEVOPS**

### **JOINT HEARING SENATE HOUSING AND ASSEMBLY HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT**

On Tuesday, February 28, 2023 at approximately 2:30 p.m. City staff will be testifying at a joint California Senate Housing and Assembly Housing and Community Development Committee hearing. The Committee will be discussing recent actions undertaken by the state legislature to increase housing production in California, to ascertain effectiveness of the legislation, and to discuss further measures that might be necessary to address the housing crisis. City Staff will have the opportunity to discuss Pomona's perspective on achieving a certified Housing Element, highlight our housing-friendly initiatives to facilitate more housing development and discuss the unique challenges Pomona faces in ensuring that new housing is affordable and that its design contributes to the multi-modal, pedestrian friendly design we strive for. 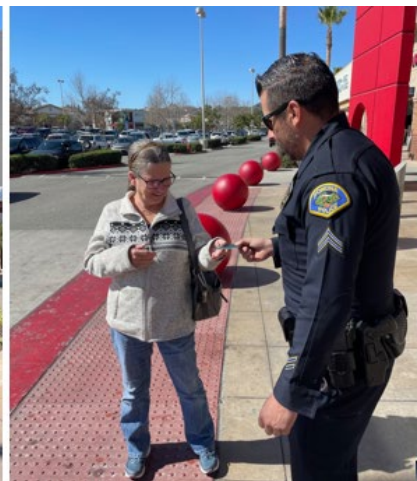
## **POLICE**

## ***PUBLIC WORKS***

### **ATHENS SERVICES TO PERFORM REVIEW OF RESIDENTIAL CARTS**

On December 5, 2022, the City Council approved the award of an exclusive franchise agreement to Athens Services (Athens) for residential and commercial solid waste, recyclable materials, and organic waste collection services. Services are expected to begin on July 1, 2023.

As the City of Pomona and Athens begin working through the transition period leading up to July 1<sup>st</sup>, Athens has notified the City that beginning next week, they will begin an audit and evaluation of the overall condition of the City's residential carts (black, blue, green cans).

The Athens team will be wearing Athens-branded clothing and will be driving around the residential neighborhoods in vehicles with Athens logos.

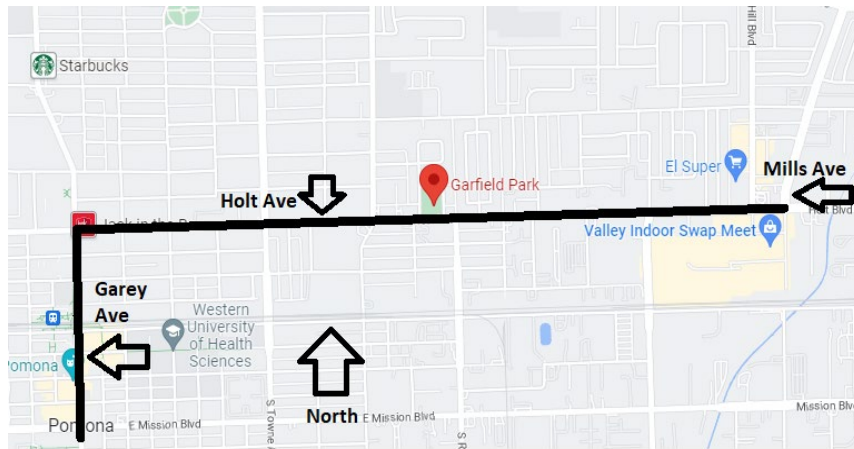
### **CLEAN CALIFORNIA GRANT - HOLT AVENUE CORRIDOR PROJECT**

The City of Pomona was previously awarded \$4,922,041 from the Clean California Local grant program by Caltrans. The City is using these funds to beautify and enhance the safety and walkability along Holt Avenue from Garey Avenue to Mills Avenue, and along Garey Avenue from Holt Avenue to Mission Boulevard. The Holt Avenue Corridor project will include the following:

- A jogging trail and exercise equipment with additional lighting and replacement lighting with LED lights at Garfield Park.
- At the underpass of Garey Avenue at 1<sup>st</sup> street, adjacent to Pomona's historic train station, the lighting will be upgraded with LED lighting. In addition, the underpass will illuminate an anti-graffiti mural, which represents the rich cultural history of the downtown area and compliments historical architecture. This connection between the mural and Pomona's downtown history creates a sense of place while also increasing a cultural connection for people who walk along the train underpass.
- On Holt Avenue, east of Garey Avenue, the sidewalks will be repaired, and work will include some landscaping of parkways to create a safer pedestrian path.

Due to required corridor grant work, raised landscape medians are anticipated on Holt Avenue from Garey Avenue to San Antonio Avenue, as funds allow.

### **WATER RESOURCES BUILDING PROJECT**

The Water Resources Building project is moving forward with utility and vertical construction. At the Public Works Yard (Yard) site located at 636 W. Monterey Ave., the project contractor Kemp Bros. is constructing the communication and electrical infrastructure. This infrastructure is being installed within Huntington Street, Commercial Street, and an existing parking lot serving the Yard. Signs about the ongoing construction and warning signs are posted within the public right-of-way and project site areas. The construction is scheduled from February 16 to March 3, 2023.
