INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY

COMMUNITY CENTER INTERNET UPDATE

After successful burn-in tests, IT is excited to share that La Casita's computer lab is now utilizing the newly installed Fiber Optic Service (FiOS). The upgrade at La Casita does away with the old DSL service @ 5Mbps and replacing it with FiOS that peaks at 500Mbps. Additionally, IT deployed Community Services public Wi-Fi at Garfield Community Center but undergoing internal pilot tests (i.e. is not yet ready for public use). Results thus far are promising as staff is able to now remotely access security cameras at Garfield Community Center, this feature will save staff time from needing to physically visit the community center to retrieve recordings. As IT fine tunes the digital infrastructure at Garfield Community Center, we will replicate that setup at other community centers.

CYBERSECURITY UPDATE

The IT team is continuing to follow recommendations from Homeland Security's cybersecurity arm, CISA (Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency), to improve our cybersecurity posture. Since IT's last update at the end of June, we have addressed another 58 findings from CISA's report. IT is also actively working on upgrading our antivirus console and replacing two aging network switches in the upcoming weeks. Please check back for more updates as we continue to make steady progress in cybersecurity.

ZONING CODE UPATE

The City of Pomona's [Planning Division](#) is excited to announce the release of the updated Zoning Code. This is the first major update since 1949. In 2021, the Planning Division set out to modernize and conduct a comprehensive revision of the Pomona Zoning Ordinance to align with our 2014 adopted [General Plan](#).

The updated Zoning Code is intended to provide a more efficient and flexible zoning system for Pomona that is responsive to the needs of our diverse neighborhoods. This Code is taking a new approach



to zoning that is tailored to the City’s neighborhoods while preserving our unique historic resources.

The Planning Division will be conducting several community meetings to present the updated Zoning Code to the public. The meetings are grouped into different focuses including small businesses, residential expansions, commercial and industrial design, and uses. 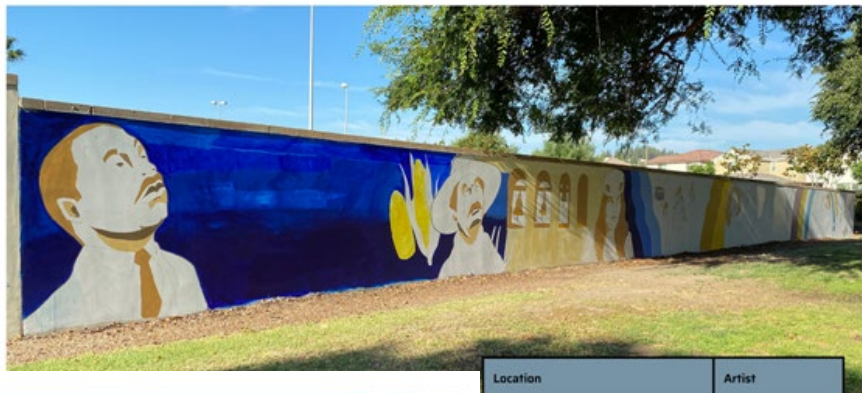

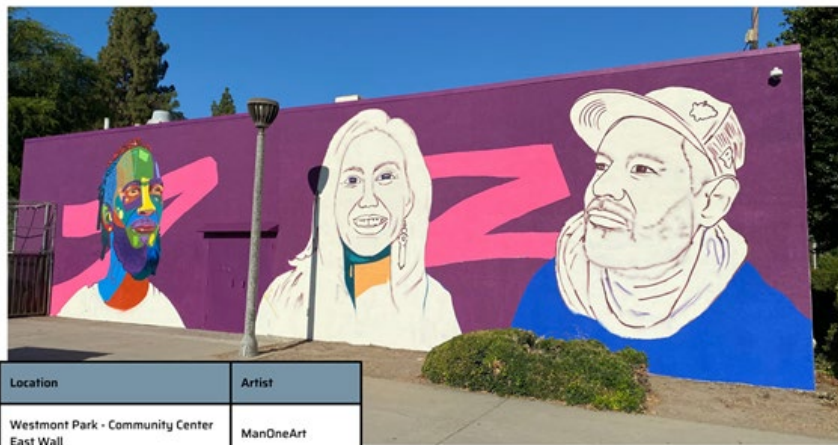
CULTURAL ARTS

NEED HELP WITH YOUR WATER OR WASTEWATER BILLS?

California Department of Community Services and Development team can assist customers in person on the 2nd and 4th Wednesday of the month locally in the City of Pomona.

How do I sign up? Call the Customer Support Team at (888) 351-4061. They can schedule you an appointment or mail an application.

The program is a federally funded program and offers low-income households a one-time payment (up to \$2,000) to pay outstanding bills for residential water or wastewater costs. The federal funds will be available until August 31, 2023, so do not wait to call and get assistance, (888) 351-4061. You may also visit <https://csd.ca.gov/waterbill> to see if you qualify.
