



## HACIENDA PARK HISTORIC DISTRICT

The Hacienda Park Historic District was designated on October 6, 2003, as Pomona's fourth Historic District. The homes in Hacienda Park span nearly 100 years of Pomona's History.

Hacienda Park contains one of Pomona's oldest homes, the La Casa Primera, and has the largest concentration of post-World War II homes of any of Pomona's Historic Districts. Hacienda Park is a snapshot of change in Pomona, as it captures the transition from ranchos and orange groves to suburban tract homes to fill the housing need after World War II.

The Hacienda Park Historic District is generally located between White Avenue on the West, Garey Avenue and Gordon Street on the East, Orange Grove Avenue on the South, and Artesia Street on the North.
