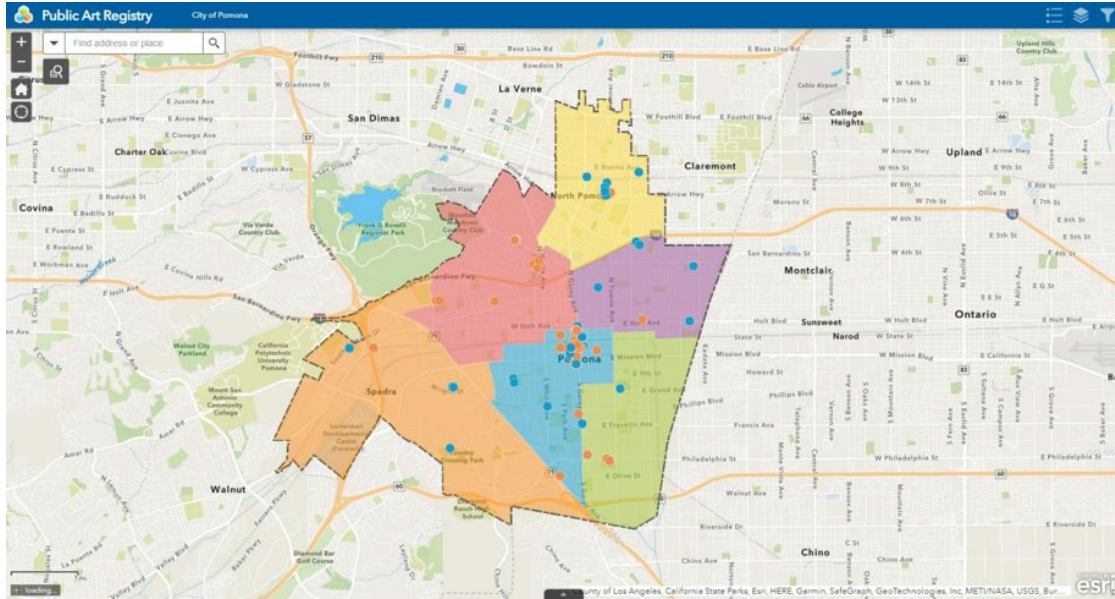

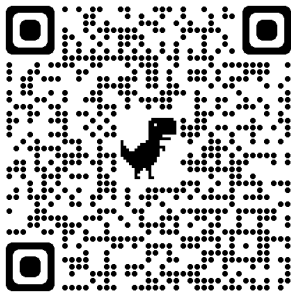


THE GAREY UNDERPASS PROJECT

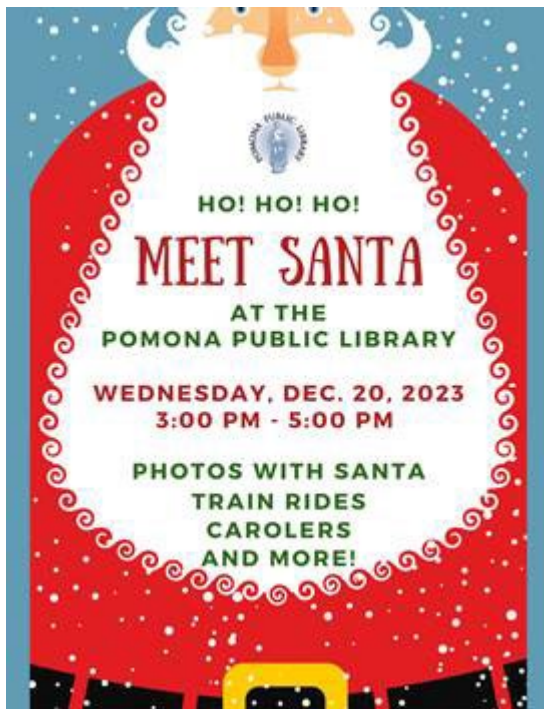

YOUTH CROSS COUNTRY WRAPS UP 2023 SEASON

Outdoor & Active concluded its 2023 winter season with a cross-country event on Sunday, December 10, 2023 at Westmont Park, with over 20 runners ages 7-13 years old participating. Athletes ages 7-10 ran a 1K and athletes ages 11-13 ages ran 2K. An award ceremony took place for 1st - 5th place in each division. During the FREE 6-week program, dedicated City staff provided a safe, balanced, and enjoyable approach to training and racing. CONFLUENCE CHOKEPOINT RELIEF PROJECT EVENING CLOSURES EB SR-60, WB SR-60

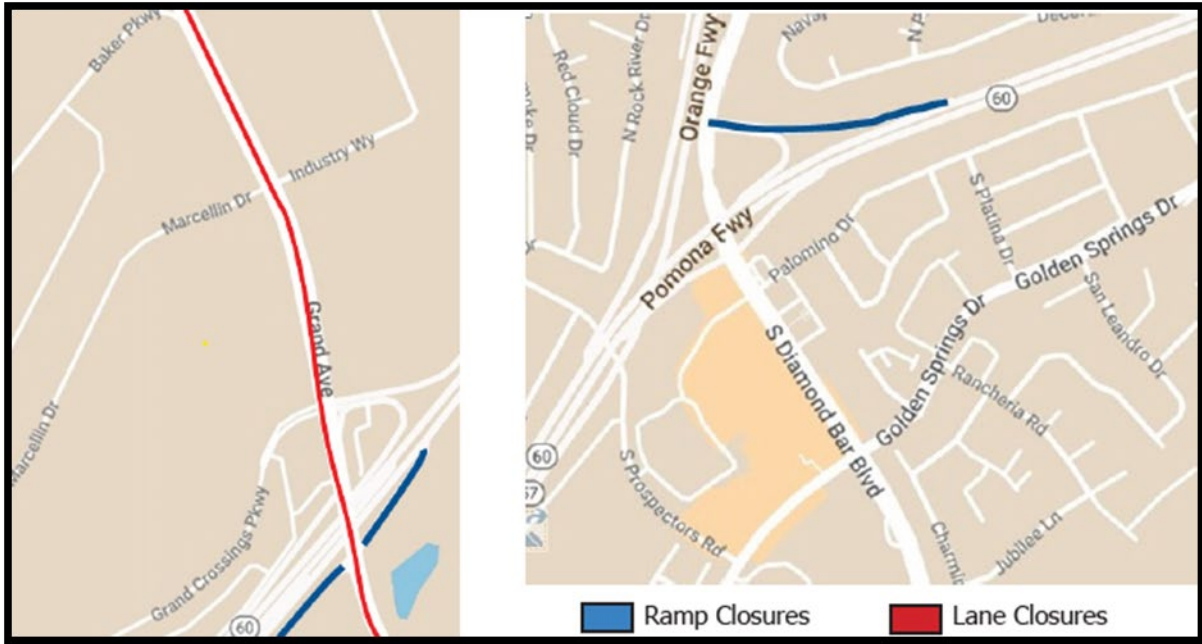
The Confluence Chokepoint Relief Project (Project) will help to improve congestion at the State Route 57 (SR-57) and State Route 60 (SR-60) area of confluence between the City of Diamond Bar and the City of Industry. Contractors will be working on the eastbound SR-60 Grand Ave. on- and off-ramps and westbound SR-60 Diamond Bar Blvd. off-ramp, and the ramps will experience evening closures. Grand Ave. will have one lane closed in each direction from Baker Pkwy. to Golden Springs Dr.

The impacts of this Project's construction in the City of Pomona will be vehicles detouring off the eastbound SR-60 at Diamond Bar Blvd. and traveling through the City to get back onto the eastbound SR-60. It is anticipated that vehicles will be directed back to the SR-60 via Diamond Bar Blvd./Mission Blvd. and the SR-71.

GOLD LINE CONSTRUCTION AND CLOSURES - GAREY AVENUE

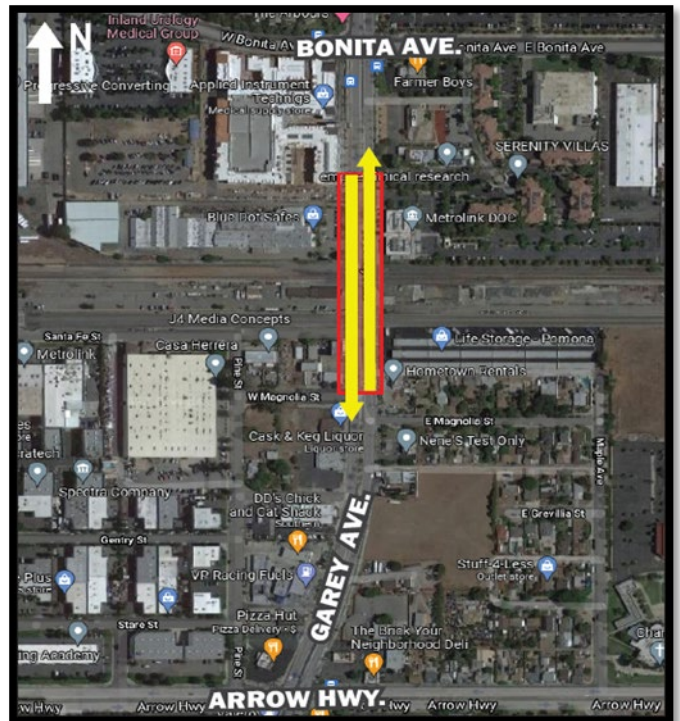
As construction continues on the Foothill Gold Line light rail project, crews will begin construction at the railroad crossing on Garey Avenue between Arrow Highway and Bonita Avenue. Construction activities include underground utility work, roadway paving and striping, and final sidewalk improvements.

Ongoing and continuing through December 2024:

- **Lane closures will be in effect in both directions 24 hours per day.** Allowable Working Hours: 7:00 AM – 8:00 PM, Monday through Saturday. Due to miscellaneous construction/testing, occasional longer working hours and nighttime work may occur past 8:00 PM.

Map details

The red area on the map shows the work zone. Access through the work zone will be available throughout the duration of these operations. Yellow arrows indicate northbound and southbound lanes in each direction.



Garey Avenue consists of two lanes traveling in each direction (northbound/southbound). One lane in each direction may be closed for construction, but there will always be one lane open in each direction at all times. During the construction activities along Garey Avenue, access to residential areas and businesses will be maintained at all times.




