



SCHEDULED SR-71 FREEWAY CONNECTOR AND ON-RAMP CLOSURES

As part of the ongoing efforts to keep the roads and highways operational, Caltrans will implement various closures along the State Route 71 (SR-71) beginning on Monday, May 13, 2024 through Friday, May 17, 2024 for road repair work.

Residents and businesses located near the SR-71 are advised to anticipate noise and vibrations associated with construction activities.

Motorists should expect delays and are strongly advised to avoid the area and use alternate routes. Additionally, motorists can check traffic conditions before they leave by visiting the Caltrans "Quickmap": QuickMap (ca.gov) Caltrans reminds motorists to "Be Work Zone Alert" and "Slow for the Cone Zone."


