POMONA'S FIRST SUMMER KARAOKE NIGHT



WATER RESOURCES

<u>CONTRACTORS REMOVE CALCIUM DEPOSITS FROM SEWER INFRASTRUCTURE</u>

The Wastewater Division within the Water Resources Department is collaborating with our on-call sewer cleaning and video inspection contractors. The contractors are removing difficult cumbersome calcium deposits from our sewer mains and manholes. To date, the contractor has removed deposits from sewer infrastructure located near Quail Creek Ln. and Village Loop Rd. in the City of Pomona.

High water tables in the groundwater and hard water are the cause of the calcium deposits in sewer mains. The deposits enter sewers through possible inflow/infiltration through sewer joints, physical cracks, and sewer manhole structures. These deposits may cause issues such as sewer blockages, surcharges, and sewer spills that could affect public health and safety.

This initiative reflects the ongoing efforts of the Water Resources Department's Wastewater Division to enhance our Wastewater Collection System incrementally.
