NALOXONE ACCESS POINT

In partnership with LA County Health Services - Harm Reduction Division, the Library will now be a Naloxone Access Point every Thursday from 11:30am-1:30pm. Naloxone (also known as Narcan) is a life-saving medication that can reverse opioid overdoses, and its accessibility is crucial in addressing the ongoing opioid crisis in LA County. Community Health Workers from the OEND (Overdose Education and Naloxone Distribution) program will have a table set up in front of the building, and will distribute

In the effort to seek community input and build consensus for the plan, the City will be undertaking the following activities:


