


Project Title: Storm Drain Facility Reconstruction - Palomares Street and First Street

Project Description: There are drainage issues at Palomares Street and First Street. The drainage facility (R.C.P.) that runs under the railroad tracks may be damaged and in need of repair. This section of storm drain should be inspected by CCTV and affect any repairs which may be needed. Permits will be required from the Union Pacific Railroad for any work to be completed within the railroad right-of-way as part of the Safety Improvements-At-Grade Crossings project, ACE will analyze and determine necessary repairs.
